**PETITION FOR WRIT
OF HABEAS CORPUS**

PROPOSED ORDER FOR RELEASE

Upon review of the filing in this matter, the Petitioner, RODRIQUEZ-BAUTISTA, Jaxell Isacc (A [REDACTED]), is hereby ORDERED RELEASED from custody.

Release from custody must occur within six hours and on the same calendar day as this order. Petitioner should be released from custody directly and without any bond hearing or custody review hearing being required prior to his release. Petitioner's release should be without any conditions beyond the standard release requirement such as those previously applied to Mr. Rodriguez-Bautista when he was first released from DHS custody. The release requirements cannot be any more restrictive than the requirements he was under prior to his arrest on December 26, 2025. No reporting or tracking restrictions such as alternatives to detention including, but not limited to, a telephone application tracking system or a wearable or physical device that would provide physical tracking information to DHS may be required as a condition of Mr. Rodriguez-Bautista's release.

Any proposed re-detention of the Petitioner based upon an alleged material change in circumstances must include a bond hearing or custody review before an immigration judge before he may be physically re-detained. In the hearing or custody review prior to any re-detention, the government must present evidence that a material change in circumstances has occurred that would newly render Mr. Rodriguez-Bautista a flight risk or danger to the community. In this proceeding, the government will bear the burden of establishing before the immigration judge that a material change of circumstance has occurred that would render Petitioner a flight risk or danger to the community by clear and convincing evidence.

The Petitioner's ability to pay any proposed bond that may be imposed upon the establishment of a material change of circumstances as outlined herein must include an evaluation by the immigration judge of the Petitioner's ability to pay the proposed bond.
