If you do not have the necessary filing fee, you may request permission to proceed in forma pauperis, in which event you must execute the affidavit on the last page, setting forth information establishing your inability to prepay the fees and costs or give security therefore. You must also

have an authorized officer at the institution complete the certificate as to the amount of money and securities on deposit to your credit in any account in the institution. If your account exceeds \$100.00, you must pay the filing fee.
