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**PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE  
PURSUANT TO FED. R. CIV. P. 41(a)(2)**

Petitioner, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves for voluntary dismissal of this action pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2).

Petitioner filed this action under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 challenging the legality of his immigration detention and seeking immediate release from custody. Following the filing of the Petition and the completion of briefing on the Court's Order to Show Cause, the Department of Homeland Security released Petitioner from immigration custody on or about March 5, 2026.

Because the sole relief sought in the Petition was release from detention, Petitioner has now obtained the relief requested. Accordingly, the issues presented in the Petition are now moot, and continued litigation would serve no practical purpose.

Petitioner therefore respectfully requests that the Court dismiss this action without prejudice pursuant to Rule 41(a)(2).
