
**ORDER PROHIBITING REMOVAL  
UNTIL HABEAS PETITION IS ADJUDICATED**

**THIS CAUSE** comes before the Court upon Respondents' Notice of Petitioner's Transfer From District Prior to Entry of Amended Order to Show Cause. ECF No. [8]. On January 6, 2026, Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus raising multiple grounds for relief arising from his alleged continued unlawful detention by immigration officials, in violation of his constitutional rights. ECF No. [1]. The Petition became ripe on February 11, 2026. Today, Respondents filed the Notice stating that Petitioner is "*en route* to Harlingen, Texas, to be staged for removal" and that "Petitioner's removal to Algeria is scheduled to occur within the next two weeks." *Id.*

The Court intends to expeditiously adjudicate the Petition. Until the Court rules on the Petition, Respondents shall not remove Petitioner from the United

States. By **February 20, 2026**, Respondents shall file a Notice advising the Court of the current location where Petitioner is being detained.
