Detention exceeds one years without bond hearing.

GROUND TWO: VIOLATION OF IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT, 8 U.S.C. SECTION 1231(a)(6)

8 U.S.C. Petitioner sustained a severe bruise to the right arm, with swelling and pain localized around the elbow joint. Acti
movement is significantly limited due to pain, and a hematoma is visible on the outer forearm. These symptoms
indicate a serious injury requiring medical attention. See attached Exhibit "B"

Petitioner has been under continuous medical care at Otay Mesa Detention Facility. Facility records confirm
a serious injury to the right arm, which has worsened, causing severe pain and limited mobility. Prolonged

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
