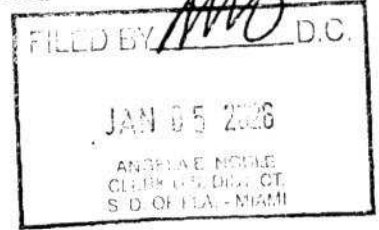

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PETITION FOR A WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 2241

**TO THE HONORABLE COURT:**

Petitioner Arnold David Vilorio Moncada, currently detained at the Glades County Detention Center in 1279 EAST SR 78 NA, MOORE HAVEN, FL 33471, respectfully submits this Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 to challenge the legality of his detention. Petitioner seeks judicial review and relief because his detention has continued without a bond hearing or timely review.

**I. JURISDICTION**

This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 because Petitioner is in federal detention and seeks relief from unlawful detention.

## II. PARTIES

Petitioner: Arnold David Vilorio Moncada, detained at Glades County Detention Center, Moore Haven, Florida.

## III. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

1. Petitioner was taken into ICE custody on November 21, 2025.
2. Petitioner has been held in detention without a bond hearing or timely review of his detention.
3. Petitioner seeks judicial review of his detention, which has continued for an extended period without meaningful consideration of release or bond eligibility.

## IV. LEGAL GROUNDS

### Ground 1 – Detention without timely bond consideration:

Petitioner has not received a bond hearing or review of detention at Glades County Detention Center.

### Ground 2 – Violation of Due Process:

Petitioner's detention without an opportunity for a bond hearing violates the Fifth Amendment's Due Process Clause.

### Ground 3 – Unlawful continued detention:

ICE is detaining Petitioner without reviewing bond eligibility. Petitioner's continued detention lacks timely review.

### Ground 4 – Prolonged/Arbitrary Detention:

Petitioner is detained for an indefinite period without judicial review or legal justification, in violation of federal law (see *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001) and laws governing immigration detention.

**V. REQUESTED RELIEF**


Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus directing Respondents to review Petitioner's detention;
2. Order release from ICE detention if the Court finds the detention unlawful; and
3. Grant any other relief the Court deems just and proper.
