1. On January 15, 2026, Petitioner appeared for a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge ("IJ") in Hyattsville, Maryland. He was represented by counsel at the hearing.
2. After consideration of the evidence and arguments of counsel, the IJ set a bond of \$9,000. On or about January 21, 2026, after Petitioner posted the bond of \$9,000, he was released from ICE custody.
