UNOPPOSED MOTION TO HOLD CASE IN ABEYANCE

The Court granted in part Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) on February 16, 2026, and ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a). ECF No. 1. On February 23, 2026, an immigration judge denied bond. On March 2, 2026, Petitioner filed a Motion to Enforce arguing that the bond hearing did not comply with the Court's order and seeking immediate release. ECF No. 14. Briefing was complete on March 17, 2026. ECF No. 17. On March 18, 2026, the Board of Immigration Appeals ("Board") issued a decision dismissing Petitioner's appeal of the immigration judge's denial of his asylum application. Due to this decision, Immigration and Customs Enforcement's detention authority is currently 8 U.S.C. § 1231(a)(2)(A).

Petitioner is evaluating his next steps in light of the Board's decision and requests that the motion to enforce be held in abeyance for 30 days to allow time for this consideration. Should he seek and receive a stay of removal, detention authority would shift back to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), as argued in the habeas petition and the motion to enforce. On March 26, 2026, undersigned counsel contacted counsel for the government to obtain Respondents' position on this motion. Government counsel indicated that Respondents do not oppose this motion.
