**PLAINTIFF'S NOTICE OF CURRENT CONTACT INFORMATION, CONTINUED INTENT TO
PROSECUTE THIS ACTION, AND REQUEST FOR ELECTRONIC FILING OR, IN THE
ALTERNATIVE, ELECTRONIC SERVICE**

Plaintiff, **Rogelio Bolufe Izquierdo**, appearing **pro se**, respectfully files this Notice in compliance with the Court's Text Order (Doc. 31), and states as follows:

1. Plaintiff is temporarily present in Ecuador following his removal from the United States.
2. Plaintiff does not presently have a fixed or permanent residential mailing address. Plaintiff is in the process of establishing a permanent residence and will promptly notify the Court upon obtaining one.
3. Because Plaintiff does not presently have a fixed residential mailing address at which Court correspondence can be reliably received, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court continue sending all notices, Orders, and correspondence to the mailing address previously provided and reflected in the record:



This address is designated solely for the purpose of receiving Court correspondence until Plaintiff files a subsequent Notice of Change of Address.

4. Plaintiff respectfully advises the Court that, despite his removal from the United States, he remains fully committed to pursuing this litigation. Plaintiff continues to seek adjudication of the constitutional and statutory claims asserted in his Complaint and has no intention of abandoning this action.
5. Plaintiff will promptly notify the Court upon establishing a permanent residential address or any other change in his contact information.

REQUEST FOR ELECTRONIC FILING OR, ALTERNATIVELY, ELECTRONIC SERVICE

6. Plaintiff respectfully informs the Court that, because he is temporarily outside the United States and does not yet have a permanent residence, international mail is often unreliable and may substantially delay Plaintiff's receipt of Court Orders, notices, and other case-related communications.
7. In order to ensure timely compliance with all Court Orders and deadlines, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court, in its discretion:

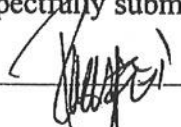
a. Permit Plaintiff to apply for access to the CM/ECF electronic filing system as a pro se litigant, if the Court deems appropriate; or

b. Alternatively, authorize Plaintiff to receive Court notices and Orders by email, in addition to the mailing address listed above.

8. Plaintiff respectfully submits that granting either of these requests would promote the efficient administration of this case, reduce delays associated with international mail, and facilitate Plaintiff's prompt compliance with all Court Orders and deadlines. These requests are made in good faith and solely for the purpose of ensuring timely communication with the Court.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Notice be accepted as compliance with the Court's Text Order regarding his current contact information; that the Court continue using the mailing address listed above unless and until Plaintiff files an updated Notice of Change of Address; that Plaintiff be permitted to apply for access to the CM/ECF electronic filing system, if appropriate under the Court's Local Rules; or, alternatively, that the Court authorize Plaintiff to receive electronic service by email; and that the Court grant such other and further relief as it deems just and proper.
