**MOTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF
COUNSEL**

Petitioner Mohamed Soliman Mahmoud Soliman Emara requests that the Court appoint the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Washington, or such other counsel as the Court may deem appropriate, to represent him in this matter. Petitioner does not have the financial resources to retain counsel as he is presently in custody. For this reason, and because the present petition presents novel and complex issues of law, appointment of counsel would serve the interests of justice. Many other ICE detainees are or will be raising similar habeas challenges against Respondents, and this Court will benefit from the contributions of experienced, federal counsel in examining these claims. In addition, if an evidentiary hearing is necessary in this case, Petitioner will need the assistance of counsel for such a hearing.

1 Counsel has discussed eligibility for IFP status with Petitioner. Based on the
2 information provided by Petitioner, counsel can attest to his financial eligibility. A
3 signed financial affidavit will be filed within 30 days.
