GROUND ONE: Petitioner's bond was denied on December 19, 2025 due to an erroneous agency decision called Matter of Yajure Hurtado. Petitioner is a Cuban asylum seeker who entered without inspection in 2022. Petitioner has erroneously been categorized as subject to mandatory detention under 8 USC 1225(b)(2) instead of the only proper detention authority, 8 USC 1226(a).

Petitioner was arbitrarily re-detained after having placed on an order of release on recognizance after his entry to the U.S. in 2022. He is currently in removal proceedings.
