**FEDERAL RESPONDENTS'
RESPONSE TO PETITION FOR
WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

Petitioner filed this petition for a writ of habeas corpus to secure release or a bond hearing in connection with Petitioner's detention by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. This petition raises legal and factual issues similar to those in prior habeas petitions this Court has decided. Per the Petitioner's own admission, the Petitioner entered without admission, and has not been granted legal permanent residency. Those issues are currently before the Eighth Circuit on expedited review in *Avila v. Bondi*, No. 25-3248 (8th Cir. docketed Nov. 10, 2025). For purposes of expediting these proceedings, the Federal Respondents, Kristi Noem, Todd Lyons, and David Easterwood, assert all arguments raised by the government in *Avila*, preserve those arguments for any appeal in this case, and respectfully request that the Court deny Petitioner's habeas petition.
