1 Federal Respondents provide the following status report pursuant to the Court's Order
2 Granting Habeas Petition in Part.³ Dkt. 10. The Court ordered the Federal Respondents to hold a
3 bond hearing within seven calendar days of the Order (and required that the hearing comport with
4 certain procedural requirements), or in the alternative, immediately release Petitioner under
5 appropriate conditions of release. Dkt. 10, pgs. 23-24. Petitioner was provided a bond hearing on
6 February 12, 2026, before an immigration judge. Ex. A. Following the hearing, the immigration
7 judge issued an order denying Petitioner's request for bond and finding that DHS established that
8 Petitioner is a flight risk by clear and convincing evidence. *Id.* Petitioner reserved appeal. *Id.* As
9 of today, information from the Executive Office of Immigration Review (EOIR) shows that
10 Petitioner has not yet filed an appeal with the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA). Petitioner
11 remains in immigration custody without bond.
