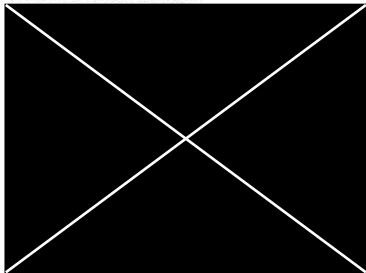

Grounds for Habeas Relief

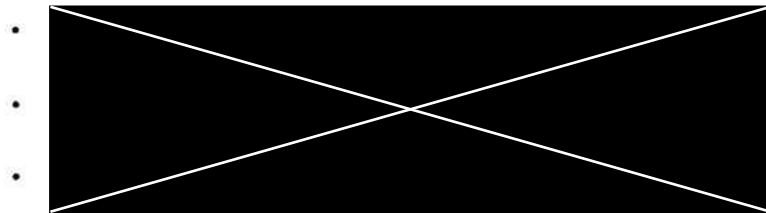


Relief Requested
