STIPULATED ORDER REQUIRING RESPONSE TO PETITION

On January 19th, 2026, Petitioner, Jose Porforio Martinez-Sopczynskik, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging his detention by Respondents. ECF No. 1, PageID.1. For good cause, the Court may set a deadline for the Respondents to respond to the petition. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2243. Accordingly, **it is ORDERED** that:

1. Respondents shall respond to the petition for a writ of habeas corpus no later than February 5th, 2026;
2. If Petitioner chooses to file a reply, Petitioner must do so no later than three business days after Respondents file their response; and
3. Petitioner has sent a copy of the petition to the U.S. Attorney's Office for

the Eastern District of Michigan by certified mail, which will constitute proper service upon delivery.
