**EMERGENCY PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
28 U.S.C. § 2241**

I. JURISDICTION

This petition is filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241. Petitioner is unlawfully detained by ICE in violation of the Fifth Amendment and *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001).

II. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Petitioner is a native and citizen of Jordan. Petitioner was released from immigration custody on July 3, 2012 because the Government of Jordan refused to issue travel documents. Jordan has never provided travel documents. Removal is not reasonably foreseeable.

III. LEGAL ARGUMENT

Under *Zadvydas v. Davis*, detention beyond six months is unlawful when removal is not significantly likely in the reasonably foreseeable future. Continued detention violates due process.

IV. RELIEF REQUESTED

Petitioner respectfully requests immediate release under supervision, an emergency stay of removal, and any other relief deemed proper by this Court.
