Claim Two:
I am not a flight risk. there are no indication that I would miss appearances at proceedings so the continuation of my detention is excessive.

Supporting (A):

I do not have criminal records I follow the law and I am safe for the community. there are no evidence that show that I will violate any rules during the proceedings.

I am waiting for the judge order.

Claim Three:

I have been waiting for more 180 days after the judge granted me protection from deportations to my country of origine.

Supporting (A):

I do not have information in regards to why I am still in detention beyond the lawful time period after a judge decision has power, then my detention is lawful.

Claim Four:

My preexisting physical and mental health is deteriorating due to conditions of detention facility and inadequate medical care.

Supporting (A):

I have been detained since June 2024. The lack of contact with my family worsened my physical and mental health and suffer from regression.

I was transferred to another prison and have been held in a cell measuring 4 meters by 2 meters 19 hours a day for the past three months which prevents me exercising.
