Time-Sensitive Notice Regarding Removal

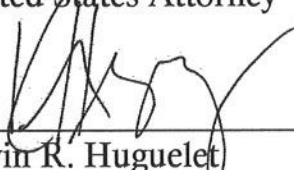
Respondents notify the Court that it appears Petitioner's removal is imminent. He apparently informed his wife that someone told him removal would occur today. According to ICE's publicly available detainee locator tool online, Petitioner was recently transferred. The US Attorney's Office does not have any specific information on where Petitioner is currently located or any planned date or time for removal.

While the US Attorney's Office does not have any other specific information to provide the Court as it relates to removal, it notifies the Court that removal appears imminent given the pending case. Respondents will continue working on their response to the habeas petition. (Doc. 5). On the merits of that petition, Respondents believe they will succeed. Yet they will inform the Court of any additional information that becomes available regarding removal in the interim.
