that you cannot prepay the fees and costs, and (2) if you are confined in TDCJ-CID, you must send in a certified *In Forma Pauperis* Data Sheet form from the institution in which you are confined. If you are in an institution other than TDCJ-CID, you must send in a certificate completed by an authorized officer at your institution certifying the amount of money you have on deposit at that institution. If you have access or have had access to enough funds to pay the filing fee, then you must pay the filing fee.

5. Only one sentence, conviction, disciplinary proceeding, or parole matter may be challenged in a single petition. If you challenge more than one, you must do so by separate petition(s).

PROLONGED IMMIGRATION DETENTION WITHOUT A
MEANINGFUL OR CONSTITUTIONALLY ADEQUATE BOND
HEARING

Supporting facts: PETITIONER WAS TAKEN INTO IMMIGRATION CUSTODY
ON DECEMBER 9, 2025. BOND WAS DENIED ON DECEMBER 18, 2025.
PETITIONER REMAINS DETAINED WITHOUT A MEANINGFUL OPPORTUNITY
FOR RELEASE DESPITE STRONG FAMILY TIES, A FIXED ADDRESS AND NO
HISTORY OF FLIGHT, CONTINUED DETENTION HAS BECOME PROLONGED AND POSITIVE
PETITIONER PREVIOUSLY COMPLIED WITH ALL PROBATIONARY AND COURT IMPOSED
CONDITIONS WITHOUT A SINGLE VIOLATION AND HAS DEMONSTRATED THAT THE
POSES NO RISK OF FLIGHT AND NO DANGER TO THE COMMUNITY

b. GROUND TWO:

DENIAL OF BOND WITHOUT INDIVIDUALIZED CONSIDERATION
OF LESS RESTRICTIVE ALTERNATIVES TO DETENTION

Supporting facts:

AT THE BOND HEARING, DETENTION WAS CONTINUED WITHOUT
ADEQUATE CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVES TO DETENTION INCLUDING
RELEASE ON CONDITIONS. PETITIONER HAS FAMILY SUPPORT

including a U.S. citizen child, and no evidence was presented showing that no conditions could ensure appearance or public safety.

c. GROUND THREE:

Continued DETENTION violates due process because removal proceedings are ongoing and no FINAL ORDER has been issued. Supporting facts: petitioner's immigration proceedings are ongoing and no final order of removal has been issued. DETENTION continues while the case proceeds, causing significant hardship to petitioner and my family (petitioner family) including separation from my minor child and inability to support my household.

d. GROUND FOUR: DETENTION IS NOT JUSTIFIED BY FLIGHT RISK OR DANGER TO THE COMMUNITY

Supporting facts: petitioner has consistently complied with immigration requirements, including appearing at a scheduled ICE check-in on December 4, 2025. petitioner has a fixed residence, strong family ties including a U.S. citizen child, and no history of absconding. Conditions of release could reasonably ensure appearance at future proceedings and public safety.

Relief sought in this petition: ME AS A petitioner respectfully requests that the Court Order respondents to immediately release petitioner from immigration detention, or in the alternative, order a prompt and constitutionally adequate bond hearing before an immigration judge with considerations of condition of release

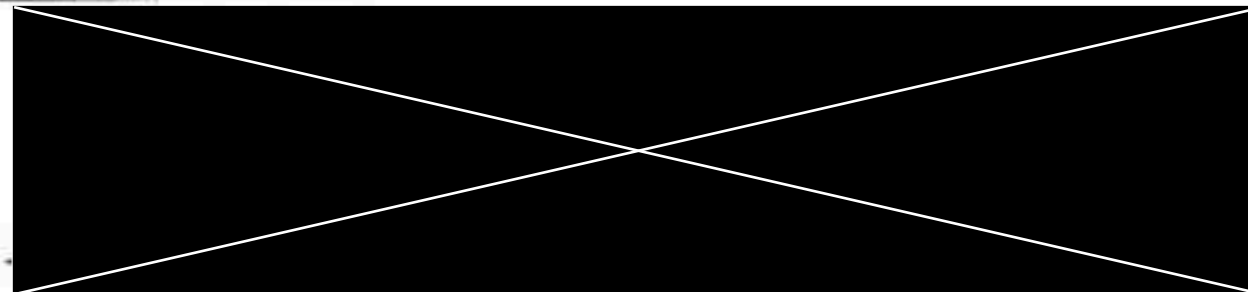
