RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

Respondents file this status report with the Court pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF No. 4), confirming the Petitioner received a bond hearing and was subsequently released from custody after the hearing:

1) On February 3, 2026, Petitioner was ordered to have a bond hearing or to be released from custody by February 10, 2026, because the Petition for Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) was granted in part by US District Judge Kathleen Cardone.

2) Respondent was required to file a status report regarding the release of the Petitioner pursuant to the Court's order by February 10, 2026.

3) Respondent confirms that Petitioner was provided with a bond hearing on February 5, 2026. The immigration judge granted the Petitioner bond on that date. On February 9, 2026, the Petitioner posted bond and was released at or about 4:30pm. Further, the ICE database also reflects that the Petitioner is not detained as of February 10th, 2026.
