JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to Judge Griggsby's January 30, 2026 Order, granting Petitioner's Habeas Corpus Petition in part and requiring a status update on or before February 13, 2026, ECF No. 9, Petitioner Cucum Poroj and Respondents through undersigned counsel are jointly submitting the following status report.

1. Respondents provided Petitioner Cucum Poroj with a bond hearing in an Immigration Court with jurisdiction over Petitioner's detention on February 10, 2026.
2. Petitioner was represented by Counsel Noll at the bond hearing. Immigration Judge Roberto Amaya conducted the bond hearing. He granted Petitioner Cucum Poroj a bond of \$10,000.
3. Petitioner's obligor was able to pay the bond on February 12, 2026. Petitioner's obligor received notice from Respondent DHS ICE that release would be effectuated upon the

obligor uploading to ceBonds proof of Petitioner Cucum Poroj's travel arrangements back to Maryland.

4. As of the time of filing this joint status report, Petitioner's family is arranging these travel plans with the expectation that Mr. Cucum Poroj will be released from DHS ICE custody upon the agency's receipt of the travel arrangements.
5. All parties are in compliance with Judge Griggsby's January 30, 2026 Order, ECF No. 9.
