MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT

Jose Manuel Torres Ramirez, ("Petitioner") files this motion for an entry of final judgment pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58. Respondents have not provided a position on this motion.

Petitioner filed a Verified Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF 1) on January 23, 2026, and a Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction (ECF 2) on the same date. On January 26, 2026, this Court granted, in part, Petitioner's Temporary Restraining Order and ordered Respondents to show cause why his Verified Writ of Habeas Corpus should not be granted. ECF 9. After briefing by the parties, this Court on February 12, 2026, granted in part Petitioner's Verified Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF 1)

and converted its previously issued temporary restraining order (ECF 2) into a preliminary injunction. ECF 14.

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 58, it appears that this Court's February 12, 2026, Order is not a final judgment and Petitioner's case remains open until the Court issues a "separate document" into the record indicating that the case is resolved with a final judgment. Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 58. Petitioner now respectfully moves for such a judgment. In the alternative, Petitioner requests an order clarifying whether this Court's Order (ECF 14) constitutes a final judgment.
