MOTION TO EXPEDITE AND FOR STATUS REPORTS

Petitioner moves for expedited consideration and a prompt hearing within 7 days, and for short status reports regarding custody and production of records based on the following grounds:

- Petitioner is a civil detainee with an approved I-130, an approved I-601A, and is NVC DQ; he is solely awaiting the scheduling of his consular interview;
- The charges are pending with a hearing on February 4, 2026;
- Prolonged detention without a meaningful hearing causes irreparable harm and impedes ongoing consular processing;
- The government can and should promptly produce basic custody records and address custody on an expedited schedule.
