**MOTION FOR ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND TO DIRECT SERVICE**

Petitioner moves for an Order directing Respondents to show cause why the relief requested in the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 should not be granted, and to direct service consistent with habeas practice. Petitioner further requests prompt production of the basic custody record.

1. Posture. Petitioner is civilly detained at Stewart Detention Center under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a). There is no final order of removal. Petitioner was transferred to ICE following a December 14, 2025 traffic stop; the criminal case is pending with a hearing set for February 4, 2026.
2. Due Process Need for Speed. Prolonged civil detention without a meaningful custody hearing causes irreparable harm. Prompt response and record production are necessary to enable judicial review and to set appropriate conditions of release or a prompt bond hearing.
3. Record Production. DHS has not served a Form I-286 (Notice of Custody Determination) or produced a Form I-213 or any other basic custody records; production will clarify the asserted flight-risk/danger basis, if any.

**REQUESTED RELIEF**

- a. Within 7 days, Respondents shall file a written response to the Petition and produce the

custody record, including any Form I-213, any Form I-286 or written custody determination, and any risk assessment or custody review relied upon;

- b. Petitioner may file a reply within 7 days after Respondents' response;
- c. No Transfer: Respondents shall not transfer Petitioner outside the Middle District of Georgia during the pendency of this action without prior leave of Court;
- d. Removal: Petitioner and Counsel must receive at least a 48-hour notice of removal;
- e. Service: The Clerk shall serve this Order and the Petition via CM/ECF on the United States Attorney for the Middle District of Georgia and by U.S. Mail on the Warden at Stewart Detention Center, 146 CCA Road (GPS: 79 Holder Road), Lumpkin, GA 31815.
