**RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION OF  
AMENDED TRO (ECF No. 18)**

Respondents, by and through the undersigned counsel, hereby request that the Court clarify whether it is acceptable for Respondents to release Petitioner from custody outright—as opposed to release to another detention center—under the current amended TRO.

Respondents aver that they intend to reconsider their initial bond determination and either allow Petitioner the opportunity to post bond or alternatively release him. Doing so would obviate the need for an EOIR bond redetermination hearing provided that Petitioner does not seek to challenge ICE's new determination.

In light of the language in the amendment TRO permitting "Respondents to temporarily move Petitioner from the Orange County Jail for the explicitly limited purpose of conducting the bond hearing he is entitled to under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a)"

Respondents seek clarification from the Court as to whether Petitioner's outright release in light of a new ICE bond determination would be acceptable.
