MOTION TO ENFORCE JUDGMENT

1. Petitioner, Marcos L., filed a Petition for Habeas Corpus and a request to require Respondents to return all his seized property upon release.
2. The Court ordered Respondents release Petitioner immediately and upon release, the Respondents were “ordered to return Petitioner’s work permit, driver’s license, and any other seized documents, property, or effects seized during his arrest[.]” Dkt. 15 at 2.
3. Respondents filed a status report on February 10, 2026, and confirmed Petitioner’s release. Dkt. 17. However, the report was notably silent about whether Petitioner’s property was returned.
4. Undersigned counsel spoke with the Petitioner through a Spanish interpreter on February 10, 2026, at around 12:15 pm and learned that Respondents failed to return Petitioner’s driver’s license and work permit.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that this Court grant the following relief:

- a. Maintain jurisdiction over this matter;
- b. Order the Respondents to return the driver's license and work permit to undersigned counsel's office by noon on February 11, 2026, and to file a status report on the same day confirming delivery of the items;
- c. Alternatively, Petitioner seeks an order for Respondents to return the driver's license and work permit to the office of Petitioner's counsel by a definite time of the Court's choosing in order to ensure their prompt and secure delivery;
- e. Grant any other and further relief that this Court deems just and proper.
