STATUS REPORT BY RESPONDENTS

Respondents provide this Status Report, per the Court's Order, ECF No. 13 (entered 2/9/26). In that Order, the Court granted Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus, ordered his immediate release from custody, and directed Respondents to "file a status report within TWO DAYS of this order"—that is, no later than February 11, 2026—"to certify compliance[.]" ECF No. 13 at 13.

Respondents report that the government has complied with the Court's Order. Petitioner was released from custody on February 9, 2026, without prohibited conditions of release or supervision, as described by the Court.
