**PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF DEPORTATION FOLLOWING FILING OF HABEAS
PETITION**

Petitioner files this notice to notify the Court of Petitioner's removal from the United States despite the filing and pending adjudication of Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus. On January 28, 2026, Petitioner brought this habeas claim, seeking to enjoy Respondents from deporting Petitioner pending these proceedings, and seeking Petitioner's release from custody or in the alternative, a bond redetermination hearing before an immigration judge. (Doc. 1). On January 30, 2026, this honorable Court directed Respondents to show cause why Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus should not be granted and allowed Respondents until February 20, 2026, to do so. (Doc. 5). Petitioner's attorney was just informed by a family member of the Petitioner that he has been deported to Mexico either on January 30, 2026, or January 31, 2026. Petitioner was removed from the United States to Mexico without prior notice to counsel.

This notice is provided for the Court to be appraised of the current custodial status of the Petitioner. As of the date of this notice, the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus remains pending before this Court and has not been adjudicated. Petitioner seeks any relief this Court deems just and proper given the circumstances of removal following the filing of this habeas claim.
