Federal Respondent's Status Report

Pursuant to this Court's order issued on February 12, 2026, Respondent files this status report regarding Petitioner. A bond hearing was held before Immigration Judge Dean Tuckman on February 19, 2026, as ordered by the Court. Judge Tuckman denied Petitioner's request for a change in custody status, finding that Petitioner poses a flight risk. This decision was based on Petitioner's entry into the United States without inspection following several unsuccessful attempts, failure to pursue any form of immigration relief, ineligibility for asylum due to a missed application deadline, and the likelihood of removal to a country other than Petitioner's home country. *See* Exh. A (Immigration Judge Order, Dated December 19, 2026).
