RESPONSE TO PETITION
FOR WRIT OF HABEAS
CORPUS**

Petitioner filed this petition for a writ of habeas corpus to secure a bond hearing in connection with Petitioner's detention by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. This petition raises legal and factual issues similar to those in prior habeas petitions this Court has decided. Those issues are currently before the Eighth Circuit on expedited review in *Avila v.
