**FEDERAL RESPONDENTS'
RESPONSE TO PETITION FOR
WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

The habeas petition in this matter has become moot. Petitioner challenges his immigration detention by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, but the agency has informed the undersigned counsel that Petitioner was released from custody on February 7, 2026 at 7:50 P.M. He was released from the Bishop Henry Whipple Federal Building. To the extent Petitioner seeks monetary reimbursement or compensation, any such relief would be well outside the scope of a habeas corpus petition. Whatever relief the Court could have granted in habeas has already occurred.

Accordingly, Respondents respectfully submit this matter should be dismissed for lack of a live case or controversy.
