**MOTION TO EXPEDITE CONSIDERATION
IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
(28 U.S.C. § 2241)**

Petitioner, ALIESKYS VENEGA SANABRIA (A# XXXXXXXXXX), by and through his Next Friend, ANAYSA DEL SOL LEAL, respectfully moves this Honorable Court for expedited consideration of the pending Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and accompanying motions, based on the urgent circumstances set forth below.

I. URGENT FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Petitioner is currently detained at the Bluebonnet Detention Facility under conditions that pose an immediate risk to his physical and mental health. He has suffered illness with high fever and has been denied adequate medical treatment and medication.

Petitioner has also been subjected to ongoing psychological harassment, intimidation, and coercion by detention facility personnel, including pressure to sign deportation documents. These conditions create a substantial and irreparable risk of harm if judicial review is delayed.

II. LEGAL STANDARD FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW

Federal courts possess inherent authority to expedite habeas proceedings where irreparable harm is likely absent immediate judicial intervention. See *Landis v. North American Co.*, 299 U.S. 248 (1936). Due process requires prompt review where liberty interests are at stake.

III. ARGUMENT

A. IRREPARABLE HARM

Continued detention under abusive and medically dangerous conditions constitutes irreparable harm that cannot be remedied after the fact.

B. LIKELIHOOD OF SUCCESS ON THE MERITS

Petitioner has demonstrated substantial constitutional violations, including unlawful arrest, due process violations, and inhumane conditions of confinement.

C. BALANCE OF EQUITIES AND PUBLIC INTEREST

The balance of equities favors expedited review, as Petitioner poses no danger to the community and has strong family and community ties. The public interest is served by constitutional compliance.

IV. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Grant expedited consideration of the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus;
2. Expedite review of the Motion for Immediate Release;
3. Grant any other relief deemed just and proper.
