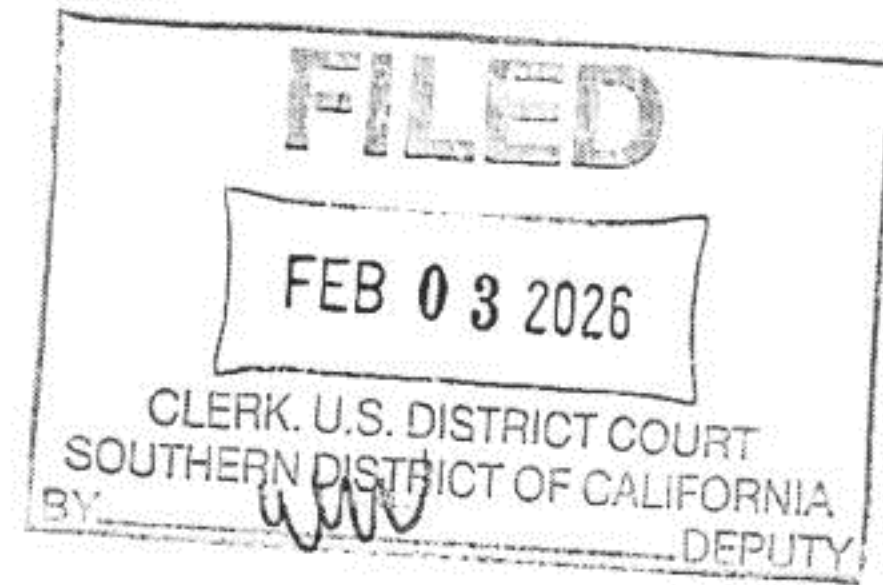
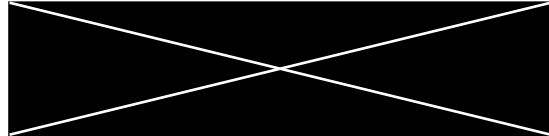

- Order immediate release under supervision.
- Any other relief deemed appropriate.
