

1. To obtain temporary and preliminary injunctive relief, Petitioner must demonstrate that (1) he is likely to succeed on the merits, (2) he is likely to suffer irreparable harm in the absence of preliminary relief, (3) the balance of equities tips in his favor, and (4) an injunction is in the public interest. *Winter v. Nat. Res. Def. Council, Inc.*, 555 U.S. 7, 20 (2008).

2. When the government is a party, the balance of equities and public interest merge. *Nken v. Holder*, 556 U.S. 418, 435 (2009).

3. Petitioner is likely to succeed on the merits on all counts of his habeas petition. He is a non-violent asylum seeker who was illegally and unlawfully arrested by respondents as part of a capricious and undue scheme to harm petitioner.

4. Petitioner has suffered and will continue to suffer irreparable harm as his fundamental liberty interest is being alienated by Respondents.

5. This injunction is fundamentally in the public interest, as petitioner's constitutionally guaranteed rights are being violated by the Respondents.

For the reasons set forth above, Petitioner requests that this Honorable Court grant Petitioner his emergency motion for Temporary Restraining Order and ORDER Respondents to keep petitioner within the jurisdiction of the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, Respond to the above Writ of Habeas Corpus within 72 hours of service of this Honorable Court's order.
