PETITIONER'S MOTION TO ENFORCE

Petitioner Reinaldo Guevara Martinez ("Petitioner") respectfully moves to enforce this Court's habeas order, which directed Respondents to provide Petitioner with a "bond hearing [that] shall be conducted pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) and 8 C.F.R. §§ 236.1, 1003.19, and 1236.1" and which mandated that Respondents "provide Guevara Martinez with any other process due to him under these provisions." Dkt. No. 8 at 4. For the reasons described in the accompanying memorandum of law and exhibits, Respondents failed to comply with this Court's order. Therefore, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court order his immediate release.

Respondents oppose this motion. However, Respondents consent to an abbreviated briefing schedule, as requested in a separate, concurrent motion.
