STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO ECF NO. 9

The Court granted Petitioner's petition for a writ of habeas corpus and ordered Respondents to release Petitioner from custody and transport him back to Lake Worth, Florida, within 36 hours of the Court's Order and to confirm the same in writing by February 24, 2026. ECF No. 9 at 7. The Court also clarified that Petitioner would remain in Respondents' temporary custody for the sole purpose of effectuating his return to Lake Worth, Florida. *Id.* at 6-7.

The Court's order was served on undersigned counsel on Friday, February 20, 2026, at 11:01 AM MST. Respondents transported Petitioner to his residence in Lake

Worth, Florida, before 6:50 PM MST on Saturday, February 21, 2026, where he was released from custody.
