**RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT
IN COMPLIANCE WITH COURT ORDER (ECF No. 11)**

In an Order issued on February 20, 2026 (ECF No. 11), the Court granted Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) and ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a custody hearing within seven days of the issuance of the Order. The Order also required the Respondents to file a status report within five days of the hearing, stating whether Petitioner was granted bond, and, if his request for bond was denied, the reasons for that denial.

In accordance with that Order, Respondents hereby provide this status report. A bond hearing before an immigration judge was held on February 27, 2026, within seven days of the issuance of the Order. This status report is filed on March 4, 2026, within five days of the bond hearing. At the February 27, 2026 bond hearing, the immigration judge determined that Petitioner should be released on bond in the amount of \$5,000.
