Supporting facts:

I am currently detained by ICE at the Aurora Contract Detention Facility in Aurora, Colorado, and have been in custody for approximately two months. I do not have any criminal record and I am not a danger to the community. I am not subject to a final order of removal, and my immigration case is still pending.

I requested a bond hearing, but I was informed that the Immigration Court did not have jurisdiction to set bond in my case. As a result, I have remained detained without an individualized determination of whether my continued detention is justified.

Prior to my detention, I was working and living in a stable environment. I have a United States citizen sponsor with whom I have lived for the past twelve months, who is willing to provide housing and support if I am released.

Given these circumstances, my continued detention without a bond hearing has become prolonged and unreasonable and violates my right to due process. I respectfully ask this Court to review the legality of my detention and grant appropriate relief, including release from custody or an order requiring a prompt bond hearing.


