MOTION TO CLARIFY

Petitioner, through counsel, respectfully asks the Court for clarification regarding the standard of proof at the court-ordered bond hearing. In *Batz Barreno v. Baltasar*, 25-cv-3017-GPG, 2025 WL 3190936, at *3 (D. Colo. Nov. 14, 2025), a legally identical case litigated by the undersigned counsel, this Court ordered that the “government must prove risk of flight by a preponderance of the evidence, and it must prove dangerousness to any other person or to the community by clear and convincing evidence.”

Petitioner respectfully asks for clarification specifying that the same standard of proof shall apply in this case.
