PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

(28 U.S.C. § 2241)

I. Petitioner Information

Petitioner **Mansurov, Akhror**, A-Number , date of birth  is a civil immigration detainee.

II. Custody and Jurisdiction

Petitioner has been continuously detained since **October 25, 2025**, a period of **over 100 days**.

Petitioner is confined at:

This Court has jurisdiction under **28 U.S.C. § 2241** because Petitioner is detained within the **Middle District of Pennsylvania**.

III. Statutory Basis for Detention

Petitioner is detained pursuant to **8 U.S.C. § 1226(a)** and is therefore **eligible for release on bond or on conditions**.

Petitioner is **not subject to mandatory detention** under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(c).

IV. Factual Background

1. Petitioner is in removal proceedings.
2. Petitioner has **no criminal convictions or pending criminal charges**.
3. Petitioner poses **no danger to the community and no flight risk**.
4. ICE has failed to justify continued detention through an individualized determination.
5. ICE has failed to meaningfully consider **alternatives to detention**.

V. Legal Grounds for Relief

Petitioner's prolonged civil detention violates the **Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment**.

Under Third Circuit precedent, prolonged detention under §1226(a) without adequate procedural safeguards is unconstitutional, including:

- **Zadvydas v. Davis**, 533 U.S. 678 (2001)
- **Diop v. ICE/Homeland Sec.**, 656 F.3d 221 (3d Cir. 2011)
- **Chavez-Alvarez v. Warden York City. Prison**, 783 F.3d 469 (3d Cir. 2015)

Petitioner's detention, now exceeding **100 days**, has become **unreasonable, excessive, and punitive**, despite being civil in nature.

VI. Relief Requested

Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

- A. Declare Petitioner's continued detention unlawful;
- B. Order **immediate release without bond**;
- C. In the alternative, if release without bond is not granted, order a **minimal bond amount that Petitioner can realistically afford**; and
- D. Grant any other relief the Court deems just and proper.
