STIPULATION AND ORDER

Petitioner, a non-citizen detained by immigration authorities, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus on February 11, 2026 (ECF 1). Respondents' response is due February 17, 2026. (ECF 3).

The parties acknowledge this Court's Order of February 12, 2026 (ECF 3) prohibiting Respondents from transferring Petitioner from the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. However, prior to the issuance of that Order, on February 11, 2026, Petitioner was moved to the Moshannon Valley Processing Center in the Western District of Pennsylvania.

The parties stipulate that, pending the Court's ruling on the habeas petition, Petitioner will not be removed from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and that jurisdiction remains within the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

The parties further stipulate to the Court deciding this matter on the papers.
