**STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO THE COURT'S MARCH 19, 2026, ORDER  
(ECF No. 21)**

Pursuant to the Court's March 19, 2026, Order (ECF No. 21), Respondent provides this status report. The Court's Order required Respondents "to file a status report within 24 hours of this Order, confirming that ICE has received Petitioner's passport from the Consulate of Poland." ECF No. 21 at 9. The Order further stated that, "[o]nce the Court has received such confirmation, and so long as the Court is aware of no other issues preventing Petitioner's scheduled March 21, 2026 voluntary departure, the motion to vacate will be granted." *Id.* at 9-10.

Respondent confirms that ICE received Petitioner's passport from the Consulate of Poland on March 19, 2026.
