JOINT STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO ORDER AT ECF NO. 15

The Court granted in part Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) on February 27, 2026, and ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) within seven days of the Order,¹ and for the parties to file a status report within five days of the bond hearing, indicating whether the bond hearing was held and whether bond was granted or denied. ECF No. 15, at 6.

¹ The last day for Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing was, therefore, March 6, 2026.

Petitioner received a bond hearing on March 6, 2026, and bond was granted. See Exhibit 1, Bond Decision and Order. The bond hearing was held in accordance with the Court's Order, and this Joint Status Report is timely.
