**STATUS REPORT**

Respondents submit this Status Report in response to the Court's Order granting the Petition in this case (ECF No. 14). That Order required Respondents to "immediately release Ms. Carrillo Alonzo from detention" and, if she resides outside of Colorado and is only in this state because Respondents transferred her here, to transport her back to her place of residence outside of Colorado at Respondents' expense within 36 hours of the Order. *Id.* at 5-6. The Court further ordered Respondents to "confirm in writing Petitioner's release from custody and, if necessary, her return home" on or before Monday, March 2, 2026. *Id.* at 6.

Respondents hereby confirm that Petitioner was released from custody on February 25, 2026. Because Petitioner resides in Colorado, Respondents did not transport her elsewhere upon her release.
