JOINT STATUS REPORT

Petitioner and Respondents, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby submit the following Joint Status Report, pursuant to the Court's February 24, 2026 order, *see* ECF No. 11, to provide a status report within seven days of the date of the Order. The Parties aver the following:

1. On Wednesday, February 25, 2026, Respondents released Petitioner from custody in California City, CA. She was released pursuant to an order of Release on Recognizance (ROR). The ROR provides that Petitioner is to attend a scheduled appointment with the Baltimore ICE District Office on July 29, 2026, at 9 AM.
2. Upon her release, Respondents did not provide Petitioner with any of her personal property seized at the time of her arrest, including her phone, identification documents, and Employment Authorization Document.
3. On Monday, March 2, 2026, Petitioner reported to the Baltimore ICE Field Office. She also inquired as to the status of her personal property. Officers at the Baltimore ICE Field Office informed her that they did not have her property.

4. Respondents have indicated that Petitioner's personal property was mailed to the detention facility in California City, CA upon Petitioner's transfer to that facility, but that the property is now being returned to Baltimore, MD.
5. Respondents have indicated their intention to request a bond hearing for Petitioner. Petitioner's proceedings before the immigration court were dismissed on January 17, 2023, and they remain dismissed. Respondents have yet to reinstate removal proceedings against Petitioner or to file a request for a bond hearing.

WHEREFORE, the Parties request that this case remain open, as there are terms of the February 24, 2026 Order that have not yet been completed, including the return of Petitioner's property seized at the time of her arrest and assurance of the constitutional adequacy of any bond hearing scheduled.
