**PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 2241**


1. JURISDICTION

This Court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §2241 because Petitioner is in immigration custody within the Middle District of Pennsylvania.

3. NEXT FRIEND STATUS

This petition is filed by Asel Davrenova as next friend of Petitioner.

Petitioner is currently detained and unable to file this petition on his own behalf.

Next friend is a close relative and lawful permanent resident of the United States and is acting in Petitioner's best interest.

4. CUSTODY STATUS

Petitioner is currently detained by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) at the Moshannon Valley ICE Processing Center in Pennsylvania.

He has been in ICE custody since October 27, 2025.

5. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Petitioner is a native and citizen of Russia.

He entered the United States with his mother, the lead applicant, Nurgul Kalieva.

At the time of entry, he was 16 years old.

He was placed into removal proceedings when the Department of Homeland Security filed a Notice to Appear.

His case was later consolidated with his mother's case because his claim is derivative of her application.

On October 27, 2025, Petitioner and his mother voluntarily appeared at a scheduled appointment at the ICE office.

This appointment had been previously scheduled so that the court date could be assigned and their cases formally consolidated with the case of his sister, whose hearing had already been scheduled for March 2025.

The principal applicant in the family case is the mother, Nurgul Kalieva.

At that appointment, despite appearing voluntarily and complying with all requirements, Petitioner and his mother were detained by ICE.

Petitioner has been in continuous immigration detention since that date.

Petitioner has no criminal history.

He was a minor at the time of entry into the United States and lived under the care of his mother.

After arriving in the United States, Petitioner attended Council Rock High School South. In September 2025, he enrolled at Bucks County Community College to continue his education.

His immigration case is currently pending before the immigration court, and his case was recently reopened for an individual hearing.

Despite his young age at entry, his lack of criminal history, his educational enrollment, and his family-based claim, Petitioner has remained detained for several months without a bond hearing or meaningful opportunity to seek release.

6. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF

Ground One: Prolonged detention without a bond hearing violates due process. Petitioner has been detained for several months without any bond hearing or individualized determination of flight risk or danger to the community. His continued detention without such a hearing violates the Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment.

Ground Two: Detention is excessive and unreasonable.
Petitioner:

was a minor at the time of entry (16 years old)

entered the United States with his mother

has no criminal history

attended high school in the United States

enrolled in community college

voluntarily appeared at his ICE appointment

has an active immigration case pending

His continued detention is not justified and is excessive under the Constitution.

7. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

Order Respondent to provide an immediate bond hearing before an immigration judge; or

Order Petitioner's release from custody, especially in light of the fact that he was a minor at the time of entry and has strong educational and family ties in the United States; and

Grant any other relief the Court deems just and proper.

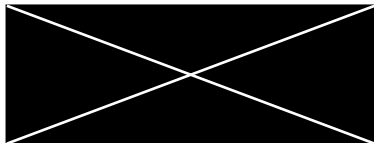
