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**RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT REGARDING COMPLIANCE  
WITH THE COURT'S MARCH 10, 2026, ORDER (ECF No. 11)**

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Pursuant to ECF No. 11, Respondents file this status report to inform the Court that Petitioner received a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge on March 17, 2026, and was detained.

On March 10, 2026, the Court issued an Order granting the Habeas Petition, ECF No. 1, to the extent Petitioner sought a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a). *See* ECF No. 11 at 6. The Court required that the bond hearing occur within seven days of the Order, or no later than March 17, 2026. *See id.* The Court also required that Respondents file, within three days of the bond hearing, a status report indicating whether bond was granted and, if bond was denied, the reasons for that denial. *See id.*

Pursuant to the Court's Order, ECF No. 11, Respondents file this status report to inform the Court that Petitioner received a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge on March 17, 2026. The Immigration Judge found that the government had satisfied its burden,<sup>1</sup> and that the Petitioner was both a danger to the community and a flight risk, and ordered Petitioner detained.
