SUGGESTION OF MOOTNESS

Respondents notify the Court that Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) is voluntarily releasing Petitioner. He should be released today.

Considering this change, Respondents respectfully suggest that this matter is now moot because the underlying relief sought in the petition for habeas corpus (release from custody) has been obtained. *See Djadju v. Vega*, 32 F.4th 1102, 1107 (11th Cir. 2022).

Respondents will docket this filing as a motion to dismiss on jurisdictional grounds, in the hope that this is the most procedurally convenient way for the Court to proceed. Respondents' counsel recently asked Petitioner's counsel how she would like to proceed (perhaps with a voluntary dismissal?), but no response has been received as of the current filing. Rather than wait further – and

potentially cause the Court unnecessary work— Respondents thought it best to file the current notice today.
