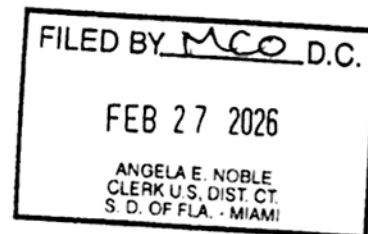

PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

(Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241)

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT:

I, Carlos Armando Martínez Monte, respectfully submit this Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and state as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

1. This Court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 because I am currently detained under federal immigration authority.
2. I am currently detained at:

Which is within the jurisdiction of this Court.

II. PETITIONER INFORMATION

3. My name is Carlos Armando Martínez Montes.
4. My Alien Number is A# [REDACTED]
5. My date of birth is [REDACTED]
6. I am a citizen of El Salvador.
7. I have lived continuously in the United States for approximately twelve (12) years.

III. FACTS OF DETENTION

7. I am currently detained by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).
8. I have lived in the United States for over twelve years and have established strong ties to this country.
9. During my time in the United States, I have maintained good moral character.
10. I have not been a danger to the community.
11. I am not a flight risk.
12. My continued detention is causing hardship to me and my family.
13. My detention without proper review violates my constitutional rights.

IV. LEGAL BASIS

14. The Fifth Amendment guarantees Due Process of Law.
15. Under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, this Court has authority to review unlawful detention.
16. My prolonged detention without proper justification violates my constitutional rights.
17. My continued detention is excessive and unjustified.
18. My long residence in the United States, good moral character, and lack of danger to the community support my release.

V. RELIEF REQUESTED

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that this Court:

1. Issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus;
2. Order my immediate release from detention; OR
3. Order an immediate bond hearing before an Immigration Judge;
4. Grant any other relief the Court considers just and proper.

VI. DECLARATION
