Petitioner John Doe (the "Doe Petitioner"), by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully seeks leave of this court to withdraw without prejudice, the pending Petition for Habeas Corpus and Petition to Proceed with Pseudonym, both filed on March 4, 2026.

Good cause exists for withdrawing the petition as Respondent's have moved the Petitioner out of the geographic region and as such this court no longer has jurisdiction over a habeas corpus petition.

LEGAL STANDARD

The Court may construe this notice as a voluntary dismissal under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1). Under Rule 41(a)(1)(A), "a plaintiff has an absolute right to voluntarily dismiss his action prior to service by the defendant of an answer or a motion for summary judgment." *Commercial Space Mgmt. Co., Inc. v. Boeing Co., Inc.*, 193 F.3d 1074, 1077 (9th Cir. 1999). Respondent has not filed a response to Petitioner's habeas petition.
